



LILO: TAKE IT EASY

Most of the time, my mom is very tender and loving. However, one day, when my siblings and I misbehaved, she transformed into something unrecognizable!


We were very scared, but when she finally returned to herself, we could see that my mom can also be overwhelmed by her emotions – just like us! And that it is also possible to forgive and move on.





Not really done-patience! You still need to wait 10 minutes. They say time flies, but waiting for the flan to cool can be quite a challenge.


